## Vacancy for Teaching Assistant

A vacancy has arisen for a Teaching Assistant to join our friendly school and work alongside the class teacher. You will need to be able to work independently and as part of a team, and when supporting the individual pupil, you will need to build a relationship to help them achieve their personal targets. There may also be occasions for you to work with small groups.

This is a full-time post 8.50am - 3.15pm (29.58 hours) for 38 weeks during term time. You will be required to work for half an hour during the lunch hour to support the children's play and social development. We will consider part-time (everyday morning plus lunch or lunch plus afternoon). This is a permanent contract starting 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022.

The applicant will need to be a positive, enthusiastic, caring and patient addition to our team with excellent communication skills and a friendly and approachable manner. Experience of supporting children with social, emotional and behavioural needs would be a benefit; however, we would require the successful candidate to take part in appropriate training. Also, a love of music and singing with a willingness to share these with the pupils would also be an advantage.
