All the Year 2 teachers will have joint PPA time on a Wednesday afternoon. You will have the support of a highly trained full time teaching assistant, who will be with the class all week.

The position is a part time (0.6 FTE) maternity cover to work with a very happy, hardworking and well-behaved class of Year 2 children. We hope the successful candidate will start work on Monday 31st October 2022 and be able to come in for some transition time before the October half-term holiday.
